1. The AGM started at 8:00pm by Mdm. Chairperson Ivy Chai Ching Hsia after quorum was present. Mdm. Chairperson shared the meeting house rules and announced the agenda for the AGM:
  - a. Confirmation of AGM 2020 Minutes of Meeting
  - b. Welcoming remarks by President of KFSC
  - c. Treasurer's Report
  - d. Election of KFSC secretary 2021-2023
  - e. Adjournment of AGM 2021
2. Minutes of previous AGM 2020 was tabled by Mdm. Chairperson.
  - a. Chong Tsewai proposed to confirm the minutes and seconded by Tan Chun Keat.
  - b. Minutes was adopted by the floor unanimously.
3. Club President Datuk Teoh Eng Kee welcomed all attendees and expressed his gratitude for the encouraging attendance. This was the second consecutive year the AGM was being held online due to COVID-19 pandemic. The AGM was delayed from the originally planned April 2021 and converted to online from planned physical AGM.
4. Datuk Teoh presented the events organised in the year 2020-2021.
  - a. Massimo buns and groceries giveaway to PPRs residents
  - b. Mentorship Programme
  - c. Fun Hub Virtual Webinar Series – 2 topics
  - d. GUPPIES Programme
  - e. Tablets donation to needy students
5. Chin Yik Ming provided further details and shared the success of the Mentorship Programme.
6. Datuk Teoh shared some of the planned club activities for the year 2021-2022.
  - a. Birthday book project
  - b. GUPPIES Programme – guiding existing students and further expansion if adequate volunteers are available
  - c. FunHub Webinar series – welcome members to provide ideas for Webinar topics
  - d. Charity event – tablets donation for needy students
7. Datuk Teoh presented membership drive activities from 2020-2021 which saw an increase of 36%. Current total members were 388 with 238 life/ordinary members and 150 student members.
8. Club financial report for the year ended 31 December 2020 was delivered by Treasurer Pang Chee Ming.
  - a. Net deficit of RM1,472.36.
  - b. Net assets of RM86,014.60.
  - c. Mah Chin Fui proposed to approve report and seconded by Charles Lim Chee Pang.

d. Report was approved with unanimous support from the floor.

9. Election of club secretary

- a. Mdm. Chairperson served as the election chairperson.
- b. The secretary position was up for election as Ng Rui Jie had served for one term (2 years).
- c. Mdm. Chairperson shared the election house rules.

Ng Rui Jie was elected as Secretary by unanimous vote, with no objection from the floor.

10. Questions from the floor:

- (i) Francis Swee Tow Terk: Do we need to spare so much cash in hand? The fund can be used for charity works this year, especially more people are needing help during this difficult times.

Datuk Teoh's answer to the question: We will try to use up the money for charity, for example the donation to PPUM which used up RM5000. Lately, many of our projects have been funded by Kuok Foundation and PBB Berhad. Having said that, we are constantly trying to identify meaningful charity projects which we can use up our fund as well. We welcome suggestions and also volunteers to implement these projects which need time and effort. Another programme which will be using the fund would be the GUPPIES Programme which currently only has 5 students and will be scaled up if we have adequate volunteers for the programme which we really need currently. Besides that, there was actually a budget allocation of RM20,000 raised during the charity dinner for the Block One project earlier. However, the project was dropped due to the pandemic and related SOP as it involves setting up a community centre at PPR. It has now been replaced by the GUPPIES Programme. Many of the usual physical charity events were also faced difficulties to be organised due to the ongoing pandemic.

- (ii) Tamarai Selvi A/P Arunasalam: Can student member be a volunteer for the GUPPIES Programme?

Datuk Teoh's answer to the question: Yes, student members are definitely welcomed to become volunteers for the programme.

11. President Datuk Teoh expressed his wish for more members including student members to join as volunteers for many of the upcoming club projects such as the Birthday Book

project and the GUPPIES programme. Members are also welcomed to contribute to the running of the club operations for instance managing the club website and publicity. President Datuk Teoh thanked everyone for attending the AGM and hoped that we could again have our physical social events soon.

12. AGM adjournment was proposed by Tan Chun Keat and seconded by Yeap Jia-Lin.
